

QMC22 Conference: Message on COVID-19

The Quantitative Methodology Center values the health of all people attending the QMC22 Conference in person. Barring any revisions to federal, state, local, or university COVID-19 guidelines, the conference will remain hybrid with both in-person and virtual attendance options.

To ensure the health and safety for all at the conference in person, we are providing a list of recommended protocols below:

Prior to or upon entrance to the QMC22 Conference

- We ask that all in-person attendees provide verification of their COVID-19 status: (a) evidence of being fully vaccinated against COVID-19 or having tested negative for the virus within 72 hours of attending.
- The registration table will have rapid COVID-19 tests available.
 - If you plan on taking a COVID-19 rapid test upon entrance to the conference, please arrive **thirty minutes** prior to the start of the conference to allow for the test to be completed.

During the QMC22 Conference

- We encourage the use of facemasks or facial coverings while not actively eating or drinking to the extent of the individual's comfort level.
- The registration table will have facemasks available.
